Welcome back term 4!

After a well deserved break it's good to be back to an exciting and fun loaded term 4. This term we have a range of school and class based events and activities happening including Book Week, Market Day and Outdoor activity Day (more information to come). We look forward to these fun events and continue to be a part of your child's learning.

English

This term the students will be continuing to practice the following text types: Recounts, Explanation texts, and Information Reports. We will be looking closely at the structure, of grammar and writing features of these text types. We will also be continuing Jolly Phonics and Grammar, Handwriting and Oral Language as part of our learning in English. Guided reading programs focusing on a variety of reading comprehension strategies will also continue throughout this term.

Science

The topic for this term is 'Biological Science'- We will be looking at life cycles of animals and plants. Focusing on how living things grow, change and have offspring similar to themselves.

Mathematics

This term we will continue to develop our number knowledge and understanding and skills with numbers to 1000. We will explore Australian Money coins and notes and use it in context in our own class shop. We will also be looking at Chance and Data concepts as well as collecting data to display it on lists tables and graphs.

History

In History this term we will continue learning about 'Past and Presents' and the impact of changing technology on people's lives at home and in the ways they worked, travelled, communicated and played.

Yr 1 English

This term the students will be focusing on the following text types: Recounts, Explanation texts, and Information Reports. We will be looking at the structure, grammar and writing features of these text types. Year 1's will be expected to write a basic Recount, Information Report and Explanation using a template. We will also be continuing Jolly Phonics and Grammar, Handwriting and Oral Language as part of our learning in English. Guided reading programs focusing on a variety of reading comprehension strategies will also continue throughout this term.

Yr 1 Science

Biological Science

Students will identify the external feature of living things. Students will be exploring the different environments that animals live in and how these meet their needs.



Yr 1 Mathematics

This term we will continue to develop our number knowledge understand and skills with numbers to 100. We will explore Australian Money ordering coins according to their value and use it in context in our own class shop. We will also be looking at Chance and Data concepts as well as collecting data to display it on lists tables and graphs.

Yr 1 History

In History this term we will be looking at how the present, past and future are signified by terms indicating time, as well as by dates and changes that may have personal significances, such as birthdays, celebrations and seasons.
