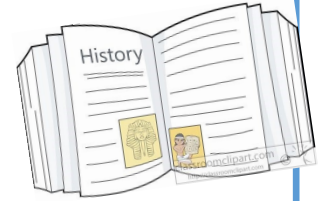

Mathematics

This term teachers will continue to work with Mathematics specialist Lisa Jane to further develop our school-wide mathematics teaching strategies. In class this term we will continue to develop our number skills and will be exploring in depth the topics of money and shape.

Health

STEM

We will be continuing to integrate STEM learning where relevant in all areas of learning.

History

In History the Year 2 Historical Knowledge is based on the theme "The Past in the Present". We will be learning about the impact of changing technology on people's lives at home and in the ways they worked, travelled, communicated, and played in the past. The students will be learning to create timelines by sequencing events in order using a range of terms relevant to the topic. We will also be looking at local history and learning about Sir Douglas Mawson.

English

This term the students will be focusing on the following text types: Explanation texts and Information Reports. We will be looking closely at the structure, grammar and writing features of these text types. We will also be continuing Spelling, Handwriting and Oral Language as part of our learning in English. Guided reading programs focusing on a variety of reading comprehension strategies will also continue throughout this term.

Science

For science this term our topic is Biological Sciences. We will be learning about how living things grow, change and have offspring similar to themselves.
