HISTORY / GEOGRAPHY


This term in W42 students will be focusing on Geography. We will be covering Asian countries and their links to Australia. There is a strong focus in this unit on the use of geographical inquiry and skills. In Geography this term, W41 will focus on the connection Australia has with other countries. In History students will study events and ideas that led to Australia's Federation and Constitution.

In Science this term we will cover Biological Science. We will be exploring the concept of plant and animal adaptations; including the structural, behavioural and physiological adaptations. Inquiry-based research will be completed to deepen the

WELCOME TO TERM TWO

This term is a very exciting term for our classes as we will be learning new topics and continuing to develop our knowledge in all areas. A major aspect of this term is guided reading. During guided reading we will be continuing to develop our understanding of reading strategies, comprehension, vocabulary and fluency.



MATHEMATICS

This term we will be developing our understanding of measurement, specifically; converting between common metric units of length, mass and capacity, and solving problems involving the comparisons of lengths and areas using appropriate units. We will be making connections, estimating and problem solving. We will analyse the importance of noticing patterns and relationships to support our thinking. Finally, we will have a focus on location and transformation.

ENGLISH

This term students will be completing a persuasive text covering the text structure, language features and devices. This will be presented to the class later on in the term. During reading, students will be summarising fiction and non-fiction texts. W 4-2 will be completing their movie and book comparison in line with the novel 'Holes' that we began reading last term. W 4-1 will continue to read class novel 'Rachel Rude Rowdy'

One of our main goals this term is to complete effective proof reading and editing skills to develop a successful, well-written piece of work.
