## **Curriculum:**

In Health and Physical Education we will continue to focus on the following areas:

- Active play and minor games
- Fundamental movement skills
- Lifelong physical activities
- Healthy benefits of physical activity
- Mental Health and wellbeing

All students will begin their own Personal Development Fitness program at ageappropriate levels.

Primary students have begun a unit of work on All Codes Football, where the concepts of attacking and defending are the key elements. Small sided Football, Tag Rugby and Soccer style games are being used to maximize individual participation.
